Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To serve the needs of the younger members (e.g. age 18-30 years) of OA in the CNMI area by:

- a) Outreach to carry the message to Health Fairs geared to Young Persons, Colleges/Universities, and other places/institutions where Young Persons suffering from the disease of Compulsive Eating may congregate
- b) Support and resources for young newcomers to OA meetings as needed
- c) Support and resources for those starting and/or maintaining any Young Person-focused OA meetings
- d) Providing contact information as well as education about OA's purpose to those professionals who may have contact with young, suffering Compulsive Overeaters
- e) Prepare and submit a budget request when prompted by the CNMI Treasurer

Additionally, it is the role of the Young Persons' Committee Chair to advise the CNMI where indicated on the needs of young OA members, as well as the legal issues regarding maintaining the safety and health of all who attend our area meetings.

PREFERRED SKILLS

Youth, experience working with Young Persons or having entered OA at a young age are ideal.
