Silent Retreat — October 20-22, 2023 — Pecos, New Mexico

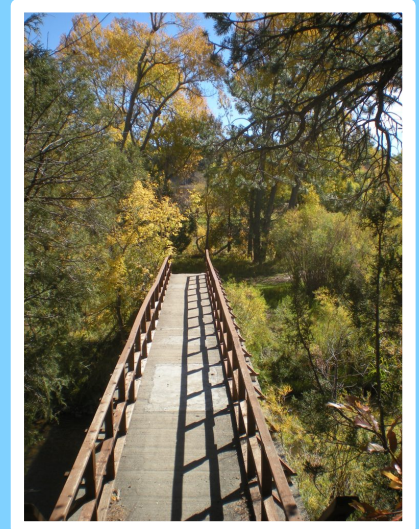
Join the committee to plan our Annual Silent Retreat in Pecos, NM.
