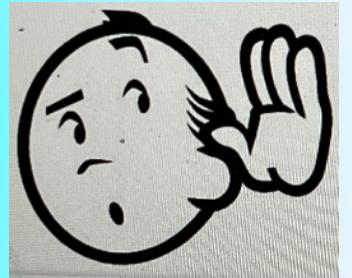

If you've been watching this space in recent newsletters, you know that CNMI will hold elections at our Annual Meeting in October to fill a number of vacant and coming-vacant positions. We hope to attract members new to service at the intergroup level to bring their talents to these positions and fresh perspectives to our monthly meetings.



Please give these service opportunities your prayerful consideration and encourage your sponsees to think about stepping up to CNMI service.

These three positions are presently vacant and can be filled temporarily before October if candidates would like to test the waters before committing to a full two-year term:

- **Newsletter Editor** – Leslie stands ready to show you how she puts together an attractive, informative newsletter. No previous experience is required.
- **Special Events Committee Chair** – Use your creativity to work with fellow members to plan programs to celebrate OA's official annual observances and to organize local fellowship events.
- **Young People's Committee Chair** – Reach out to carry the message of OA recovery to young people in the 18 - 30 age group.

We are seeking a candidate or candidates for the critical position of **Electronic Communications Coordinator (ECC)** which will also be available for election at the Annual Meeting. This individual manages the CNMI website, maintains the CNMI meeting list, and handles all electronic communications with CNMI members including distribution of meeting lists, newsletters, and other announcements. An election will also be held for the **Public Information/Professional Outreach (PI/PO) Committee Chair**, who works with their committee to provide outreach to carry the message of OA to individuals and professional organizations.

Each of these positions requires three months of current abstinence.

The **Region Representative** and **World Service Business Conference (WSBC) Delegate** positions are presently vacant and open for election. The Region Rep position requires one year of abstinence and one year of service beyond the group level, now or in the past, and the WSBC Delegate position requires one year of abstinence and two years of service beyond the group level, now or in the past. 

